HEALTH & SAFETY

All materials used have been designed for professional use, are hypoallergenic and comply with EU Standards. As with any cosmetics, some people may be sensitive to some ingredients. Upon request a small skin test may be issued. We will not be held liable in the event of any reaction.

We will not paint anyone who appears to be suffering from chicken pox, head lice, impetigo, cold sore, conjunctivitis or any other infectious skin complaint. Eczema, open cuts and grazes are not suitable surfaces to paint but a design on a clear area such as hand or arm is perfectly possible.

We will not paint signs, symbols or other designs, which are in any way racially or religiously offensive.

We reserve the right to refuse to paint anyone who is abusive, violent, or intoxicated.

All equipment is cleaned after *each* job. Sponges are washed at 90 degrees and brushes are cleaned with Isopropyl Alcohol removing all bacteria, then cleaned with shampoo.

Towels are brought to every event to protect your table surfaces. We will be as careful as possible when painting, however, we accept no responsibility if face paint/glitter gets transferred onto any surfaces at venues or homes, clothing, carpets, vehicle interiors, bouncy castles, or other soft furnishings.

COVID19

Should I feel ill or have any symptoms of COVID-19, then I will immediately self-isolate for 2 weeks. This could mean that your appointment is cancelled at short notice, but it is done entirely for your own safety. Likewise, if you or any of the people you live with feel ill or display any symptoms of COVID-19 – please advise me as soon as possible.

Upon arrival:

- I will wash my hands
- Introduce myself to you and the responsible adult. (For children's events I will need to have a **responsible adult** chosen by you on hand during the working time, this will really help me to keep children away from the face painting table until it's their turn)
- Put on my face mask and visor
- Lay Hazard tape on the floor to mark social distancing
- Sanitize and set up

During working time:

- **Painting on the face or arm** – This will be an option I'll ask.
- **One sponge per person** - A fresh sponge is used for each person which will not be reused. These sponges will then be put in a separate container to be sterilized away from the event.
- **Brushes are disinfected before AND after painting each person** – I have a wide selection of brushes available for each job. All brushes are washed thoroughly and sterilised after every job. I am doing 3 pot system during the jobs.
 - 1 Rinse water
 - 2 Soaked in brush cleaner before re-use
 - 3 Rinsed twice thoroughly with fresh water per person.
- **Hand sanitizer** – Will be available to use.
- **Face painting lips** – I will not paint the lips.
- **Glitter on face** - Glitter is applied in 'poofer type' container.
- **Face painting pots** – Face painting pots will be left closed, just in case someone coughs or sneezes in paints. If someone touches any paints, it will be fully sterilised before being used again. The paint is high quality and manufactured with anti-bacterial ingredients, so has preservatives in it to kill bacteria.

CANCELLATIONS: - Should you decide you need to cancel or postpone your event, please just let me know ASAP. You can transfer your existing booking fee towards a party any time within the next twelve months, so there is plenty of time to celebrate when everyone can safely enjoy the fun.

If you have any questions or concerns please do get in touch as it's best to ask beforehand.
Please remind your guests with any COVID flu-like symptoms to stay home!

All of these procedures have been implemented for your safety and mine. I will continue to take advice from the Government and the NHS regarding safe practice and make any further amendments as required. For now, stay safe & healthy.

REMOVAL

Face Paints are removed by washing with soap and warm water. Baby wipes will not be sufficient as many contain alcohol based ingredients which make the paint stain the skin. Some colours may linger (mainly turquoise, green & black) therefore a repeat wash with baby shampoo is recommended.

Glitter Tattoos are removed by soaking the area with warm soapy water for 5-10mins, then manipulated with baby oil and exfoliating glove.

Clothing that has been in contact with face paint should be COLD soaked overnight in washing powder before washing normally. A full list of face paint ingredients is available upon request.
